<b>Drug Facts</b>	
<b>Active ingredient</b> Hydrocortisone 1%.....	<b>Purpose</b> Antipruritic (anti-itch) cream
<b>Uses</b> For the temporary relief of itching associated with minor skin irritations, inflammation, and rashes due to ■ psoriasis ■ seborrheic dermatitis ■ eczema. Other uses of this product should be only under the advice and supervision of a doctor.	
<b>Warnings</b> <b>For external use only.</b> <b>Do not use</b> for the treatment of diaper rash. Consult a doctor. <b>When using this product</b> ■ avoid contact with eyes. <b>Stop use and ask a doctor if</b> ■ condition worsens ■ symptoms persist for more than 7 days ■ symptoms clear up and occur again within a few days. Do not begin use of any other hydrocortisone product unless you have consulted a doctor. <b>Keep out of reach of children.</b> If swallowed, get medical help or contact a Poison Control Center right away.	
<b>Directions</b> ■ Read all package directions and warnings before use. ■ Use only as directed. ■ Apply (gently massage in) a small amount of PSORIASIN to affected areas. ■ Apply not more than three or four times daily or as directed by a doctor. ■ Intended for use by normally healthy adults only. ■ Persons under 18 years of age or those with highly sensitive or allergic skin should use only as directed by a doctor.

<b>Inactive ingredients</b> Aloe barbadensis leaf juice, aluminum sulfate, beeswax, calcium acetate, cetearyl alcohol, cetyl alcohol, cholecalciferol (Vitamin D), dextrin, glycerin, isopropyl palmitate, maltodextrin, methylparaben, mineral oil, petrolatum, propylene glycol, propylparaben, purified water, retinyl palmitate (Vitamin A), sodium cetearyl sulfate, sodium lauryl sulfate, tocopheryl acetate, xanthan gum, zea mays (corn) oil.
